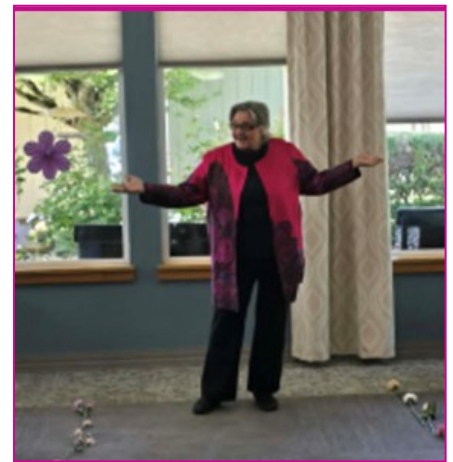
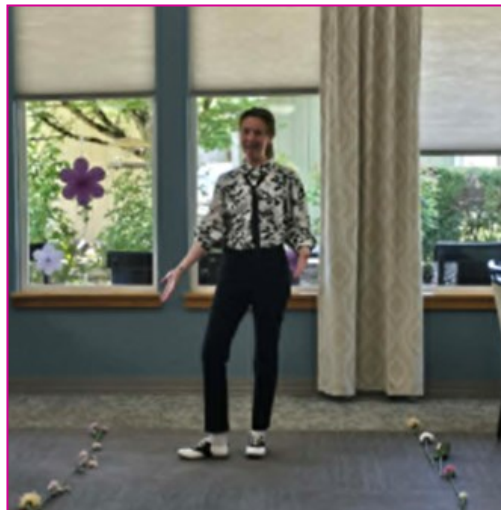


Victoria plays piano and disc golf and has found medicine in movement practices such as qi gong, yoga, and free form dance.

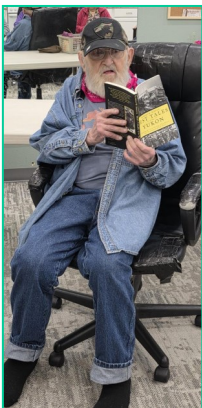
