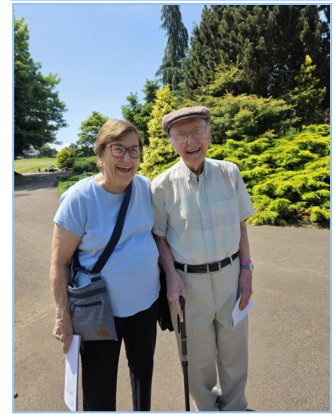
We celebrated the wonderful ladies this month. We had tea, treats, and tons of laughter.



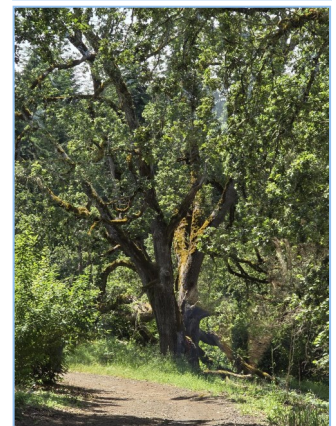
Members of The American Legion visited on Memorial day to retire our old flag and raise a new one. During the ceremony, our four Veterans were honored by Quilts of Valor.
